President's corner

The first thing I would like do is give a Thank You to Mike Dyson for his leadership of our club during the last two years. The pandemic put a damper on our club and created many challenges for our leadership. As president, Mike did a commendable job in leading us back from that difficult time.

Welcome to the 2024 version of the Colonial Shag Club. This is our 23rd year in existence. Back in 2001, there were twenty five of us taking

lessons from Cindy Goree and Larry Black, when one night in the fall, Cindy suggested that it was time to consider starting a shag club. All of us students jumped at the idea and got started right away forming a club. We had to select a name for the club and a board of directors. There were several club names suggested including Colonial Shag Club. We had a vote and the rest is history. We were very fortunate to have Jay Magness agree to guide our newly-formed club as our first president. The other board members were Tom Wiley, first vice president; Sam Martin, second vice president; Janet Richards, recording secretary; Joanie Edwards, corresponding secretary; Dudley Nachman, treasurer, Cindy Goree, director at large; Anne Soter, director at large; and Harry Walthall, director at large.

We set several priorities for our new club. The first priority was to be the friendliest club in the ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Clubs). Secondly, our club would be an all-volunteer club, meaning we all would chip in and do our part to make the club successful. That was when we only had twenty-five members. As Cindy and Larry continued to teach beginner lessons as well as more advanced lessons, it wasn't long before our club started to grow. In the fall of 2002, our club selected Menchville House as its charity and held the first charity dance. Through the kindness of our members, we were able to give one thousand dollars to Menchville House, this with only about fifty club members donating to the charity. Jay led us for the first two years and the club continued to grow. We never forgot the promise we made in 2001 to be the friendliest shag club in the ACSC, and, with the help of our members, we will strive to continue that promise.

In 2024, it is my hope that our members step up and volunteer to help with committees, dance lessons, parties, charity events, and promoting our club. For several years before the pandemic, our club had over 200 members, and we regularly had attendee numbers in the mid 70s to 80s. There are several factors that

have caused our membership to decline to fewer than 200 and our attendees to around 60ish. Obviously, the pandemic was the major cause. It is also my opinion that the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel construction is a big factor in limiting our south-side friends from attending our Saturday night events. Rick Tvelia, owner of Two Left Feet Dance Studio, has been very patient with the club in hopes that the attendance would return to the pre-pandemic numbers. This hasn't happened. As a result, as of our first dance in January, the fee to attend our Saturday night events will be ten dollars for any one who is a member of any shag club and will be twelve dollars for everyone else.

I ask all members to help our club be what it was before the pandemic. This means to volunteer your services and help us promote Colonial Shag Club. We have a ways to go, but I'm confident that with every member's help we can get our attendance back to the level we once enjoyed.
