As we start the last month of 2024, I would like to remind our members just how fortunate we are to have danced every Saturday night for the last ten years (except for cancellations due to severe weather conditions and the Covid shutdown) on a great dance floor at Two Left Dance Studio with music played by some of the best deejays in the ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Cubs). We have had dance



lessons by our club's instructors which have brought in new members. We have had several theme parties this year, most with food provided by the club and some of our members. Our members routinely bring snacks to share at our Saturday night dances.

Through the generosity of our members, we raised \$4,425 for the club's main charity, Menchville House, and donated \$500 to God's Pit Crew, a nonprofit disaster relief organization, from Danville, Virginia, for hurricane Helene relief. Along with other Virginia shag clubs, we are raising funds to support members of Mountain Shag Club in Asheville, North Carolina, who lost everything during the hurricane. Our club will be donating our club's portion of the 50/50 each Saturday night through the rest of the year to support this effort. Don Ligon, in his capacity as second vice president of Boogie on the Bay Shag Club, is heading up this donation effort for the Virginia shag clubs.

It's also time to renew your membership

To: Colonial Shag Club members

Your membership expires at the end of January 2025, if you do not renew your membership by then. If you allow your membership to expire, you will have to pay the "new member" rate to get re-instated.

In comparison to prior years, when a new membership card was issued each year, a "2025" sticker will be affixed to your current card.

There are two ways to renew:

- at a Saturday night social Bonnie Arms typically staffs the "membership table" where you can renew your membership (application form provided). Bring your membership card so that a sticker can be affixed to it.
- by mail The application form is available on the club's website and one is distributed with this newsletter. Fill out an application form and mail it to the club (address on page 2) along with the money specified on the form. Make your check payable to Colonial Shag Club or CSC (best not to send cash through the mail). If you include a stamped self-addressed envelope, a sticker will be mailed to you. If you don't have a membership card, request that a new card be mailed instead of a sticker. Or get the sticker or card from Bonnie at a Saturday night social.
